Aims

Display is used for:-

- response
- stimulation
- information
- celebration
- aesthetic qualities

Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of all staff to ensure the environment is safe and stimulating for all members of the school community who use the school.

It is the responsibility of the Head Teacher, with the Leadership Team, to ensure sufficient resourcing and to oversee the quality of the display.

It is the responsibility of the leadership team to ensure that within the school they:-

- advise colleagues
- keep abreast of current ideas, and
- suggest alternatives and improvements to the environment

Procedures

- All staff have responsibility for display in their classrooms, and in ensuring a safe, stimulating environment for the children in their care.
- Whole-school displays may be coordinated by a Subject Leader, thus ensuring progression and continuity through a skill or a theme.
- Activities which cannot be demonstrated through display are captured on photograph.
- Some displays are permanently mounted e.g. Children's Art, visits.
- At its best, display provokes response - through its content, its use of question, books and/or suggestions.
- All Classrooms have specific areas which include interactive display, e.g.:-
 - + R.E./Prayer Corner
 - + Science
 - + 'Interest Table' (Early Years)
 - + Art
 - + English/Reading
 - Children's Notice Board
 - + Class Notice Board

Principle

Display at Christ the King is part of the whole learning process, and often overlaps into classroom management and organisation.
